Teen 'tortured for being too pretty'

Face cut, wrists slashed and left for dead by two other teenage girls after row

PARIS — In a crime that has shocked France, a 14-year-old high school girl is said to have been tortured, disfigured and left for dead by two of her schoolmates, because she was considered too pretty.

After discovering the knife used to torture the adolescent was identical to the one used in the film *Scream*, newspa-

pers have competed to find exotic pseudonyms in add a Hollywood touch to a story tainted by scare videos and devil worship, said a report in The Observer yesterday.

It said the fate of "Kelly", the cover name used by Le Figaro newspaper, and torturers "Priscille", 14, and "Morgane", 13, had stirred up a national debate on youth crime.

Such crimes, in the past few days, included the murder by an adolescent gang of a father who protested against the snugging of his son and an attack on a shopping mall watchman who was set on fire by another gang.

The two alleged torturers, in custody in Mulkonne for at-

tempted murder, are from stable, middle-class families and go to a private Catholic school.

French newspapers on Friday carried accounts of "Kelly's" ordeal. She was found last Saturday covered in blood, having dragged herself from the basement of an abandoned building in the village of Saint-Vit.

After several days in hospital, she was able to speak to police of her ordeal, and her two classmates were arrested.

Both are facing charges of "attempted murder and acts of torture and barbarity".

According to investigators, the three girls — whose names are being withheld — met in the disused hospice to drink beer, but an argument de-

scended into violence.

The victim was knocked unconscious with a beer bottle, and the two others then cut her face with a kitchen knife, pulled her to the basement, slashed her wrists and left.

The pair told police they wanted to buy petrol to set the house alight but the local service station was closed. Several hours later the girl managed to escape.

Deputy prosecutor Jean-François Parietti said the younger of the two had admitted "taking part at the age of 11 in satanic rites in cemeteries with skulls", while the

14-year-old had watched the US horror film *Scream*, and carried a knife similar to the one featured in the film.

He said the older of the two was motivated by jealousy.

"She was enraptured because a young man kept asking her for the mobile telephone number of the victim," he said.

The story has received major coverage in the French press, which is pushing hard the theme of youth crime ahead of presidential elections next month.

Figures show that 177,000 children committed offences in France last year, an increase of 30 per cent over 10 years.
